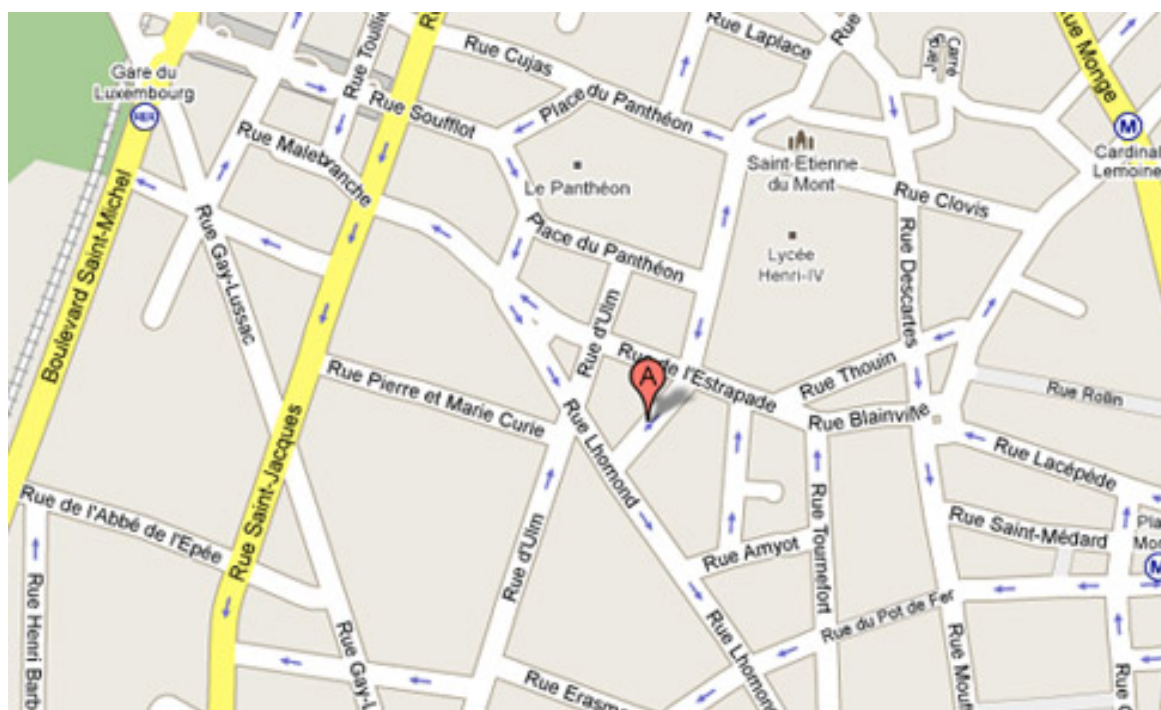


PRACTICAL DETAILS FOR THE CONFERENCE

Important information : there is no registration fee for this conference.

Location :

The conference takes place at the *Maison de la Recherche* de Paris 3 Sorbonne Nouvelle, 4 rue des irlandais (“A” tag on the map), in the heart of the *Quartier Latin* (5th arrondissement), a stone’s throw from the old Sorbonne. The nearest Metro stations are indicated on the map; the *Gare du Luxembourg* RER train station takes you directly to and from Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport (in about 45 mns).
